Easter is the time to celebrate Christ's resurrection and the new life that we have in Him. We are so thankful that we can share this new life with millions of listeners around Asia as we utilize the technologies God has given us to use.

From 13 transmitting locations around the world, Trans World Radio uses transmitters that broadcast in AM, FM, and shortwave radio to reach the multitudes of people that have no other way of hearing the Gospel. Besides these methods, Trans World Radio also uses satellite and the internet to reach even more people with the Gospel.

Many of you have asked about our station in Sri Lanka and how it fared during the tsunami in December. Our station there is near the ocean in the north western part of the country, the only part of the island that was not directly affected by the tsunami. We have been broadcasting special programs to Indonesia and to the other countries in the region that were in the path of the destruction.

In order to have a more effective ministry in Indonesia, we are in the process of adding a new curtain array antenna along with a new transmitter. This required us to ask the government for approximately two more acres of ground. We praise the Lord that the land issue has gone through the final steps of approval and should be a reality in the next few weeks. In order for this project to be completed, several more steps will have to be accomplished such as raising the needed funds for a new antenna/transmitter, purchasing the antenna/transmitter and installation of the antenna/transmitter. Once these steps are completed, we will be able to broadcast a very strong signal into all of Indonesia any time of the day!

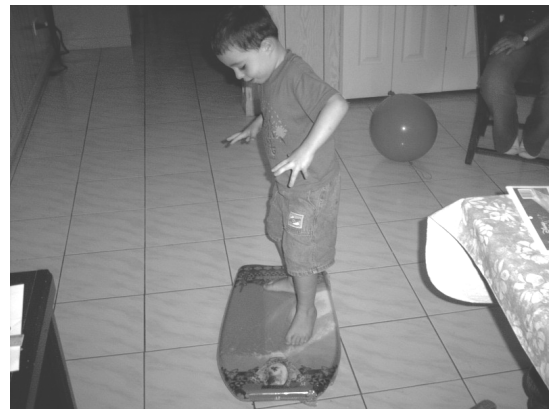
As we close this letter, we want to thank each one who has a part in our ministry through prayer and support. God has been very faithful in the last 13 years in supplying us with the support that is needed.
